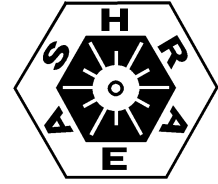


# HAMPTON ROADS CHAPTER 2009 SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES



## SPRING GOLF OUTING MAY



The Spring Golf Outing has traditionally supported scholarship funding for local engineering students. Since last year, it has taken on a much more focused role. The golf outing now funds the Gordon W. Zipperer III endowed scholarship at Old Dominion University. Years ago, Gordon W. Zipperer II, along with several other ASHRAE members, invested \$5,000 in a mutual fund. Over the years, the fund grew to over \$75,000. Last year, the Board of Governors unanimously elected to donate \$44,000 to the ODU Scholarship Endowment Fund. This initial investment, along with a \$2,000/year donation over the following 4 years, will result in a perpetual \$2000 annual scholarship for a deserving engineering student. We are currently engaged in discussions with Tidewater Community College to set up a similar scholarship once our commitment to Old Dominion has been met.

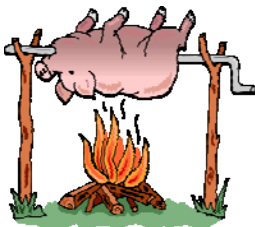
