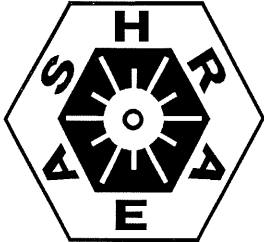

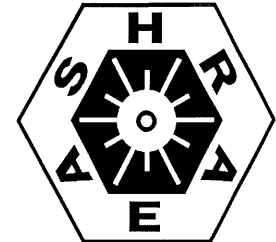

Sound Issues for Evaporative Equipment
