Chapter's Regional Conference 2017

This year's chapter's regional conference was held in Roanoke, VA the weekend of August 17th – 19th. Hotel Roanoke provided a beautiful setting in the mountains for our annual conference. Thursday's proceedings consisted of technical sessions covering steam vs. hot water, combined heat and power, variable refrigerant flow systems and lab exhaust systems followed by caucus where nominations for Society and regional officers are presented and voted on by all chapters.

At the business meeting on Friday, the state of the chapter was presented, and a summary is shown below. The chapter is healthy and growing by all measures. We are looked to as leaders for our E4K sustainability project –now entering it's 10th year! We also met all Society goals this year and exceeded fundraising goals in research promotion and scholarships.
