The latest Engineering Change Bulletin released August 10, 2018 for Tri-Service criteria addresses the DoD policy on VRF in more detail. Also, additional allowances are made for insulation.

UFC 3-410-02

The latest UFC (Unified Facility Criteria) released July 18, 2018 provides clarity on DoD expectations for control system, including BACnet requirements. The UFC also touches on cybersecurity which is becoming ever more important in our industry.
